*Format set up to allow safe travel time before and after the meet for all teams participating.

FORMAT

Swimming: Swimming and Diving will run (almost) simultaneously. The swimming portion of the meet will be held in timed finals format. All athletes may swim at most two individuals and two relays or one individual and three relays (regular high school rules). The top four athletes from each school may score points. All individual and relay entries must have a seed time and will be seeded slowest to fastest in all events. Each school may enter a maximum of four relays per relay event. The "A" and "B" relays will be scored and the "C" and "D" relays will be non-scored. Please mark your "C" and "D" relays as exhibition on your TM entries.

Diving: Diving and Swimming will run (almost) simultaneously. All divers will complete all 11 dives with no breaks (for those divers capable of 11 dives) so every diver can complete and receive an 11 dive score. If your diver can not complete 11 dives, he will dive until he has no more dives and then we will record "zeros" for his remaining dives. **Diving sheets must be emailed to brianzuehlke@charter.net by Tuesday, December 22, at 7:00 p.m.** We will be using EZ dive to run diving, so if you can, please send your dive sheets in EZ dive format. We are working on getting an EZ dive template onto our webpage for your convenience. One coach from each team should be available to score diving.

ENTRIES

Please email your swimming Hy-tek entries to entries@jenisonaquatics.org no later than 7:00 pm, Friday, December 18. The Hy-tek file can be found on the JPS Aquatics website at www.jenisonaquatics.org (PLEASE USE THIS FILE!). There will NOT be a psych sheet emailed out, but we will accept updates through Saturday, December 26, no later than 7:00 p.m.

Schools without Hy-Tek available to them are asked to e-mail their entries to the address listed above. There will be a team entry fee of \$120.00 for all teams using Hy-Tek and \$150.00 for all teams using any form other than hy-tek to submit entries. A Team Championship and Runner-Up trophy will be awarded to the teams placing 1st and 2nd overall. Medals will be awarded to the top eight swimmers/divers in every individual event and to the top three relay teams in every relay event. Top Eight finishers in all events will be presented their awards immediately following the conclusion of the final heat of each event. Please you're your swimmers and divers know this and have them ready for their awards. They will stand on top of the competition blocks with the 1st place finisher being closest to the stands. The winning coach will present the awards to the swimmers and divers.
