## JENISON AQUATICS CENTER SWIM LESSONS

**American Red Cross Adult & Tot Classes (1:8 ratio):** This class is designed for parent and baby (6-36+ mo.) to be in the water together. The instructor will guide the parents and work together to teach your child to enjoy the water at an early age with games, songs, and other fun activities. Age appropriate swimming skills and aquatic safety knowledge will be learned by the parent and child in this fun and interactive class.

**American Red Cross Preschool Aquatics Classes (1:4 ratio):** Parents are invited to observe all eight classes from the pool deck bleachers. They must remain on the bleachers; and if the parent is a detriment to the child's ability to focus on the instructor, he or she may be asked to view from the balcony. This class is designed for three and four year olds, and five year olds who are not ready for Level 1, as their first class without a parent in the water with them. Children will work on basic swimming skills to help prepare them for our American Red Cross Level 1 class.



**American Red Cross Level Swim Lessons (Level 1, 1:5 ratio; Level 2+, 1:6 ratio):** Parents are invited to observe the first and last class (ONLY) to view their child's progress. The fourth class is a mandatory Safety Day, and each child will receive a progress report. Children must be at least five years old with little or no swimming experience to register for Level 1 and must pass in order to proceed onto the next level.

**Location:** Swim lessons are held at the Jenison Aquatics Center, located at Jenison High School, 2140 Bauer Road. Enter the large, student parking lot on the west side of the high school building. Drive along the high school building toward the football stadium. When you see a large glass entryway, enter there and proceed into the pool lobby (you will see three trophy cases ahead and a stairwell to the pool balcony on your left). Follow the first hallway you come to on the right and enter the designated locker room (men's, women's, or family for those bringing children of the opposite gender).

**General Information:** Specific class requirements and descriptions can be found on our website at [www.jenisonaquatics.org](http://www.jenisonaquatics.org). Water temperature is 81 degrees. The cost for Adult & Tot lessons is \$41 for Jenison residents and \$51 for non residents. The cost for Preschool Aquatics and Level Lessons is \$51 for Jenison residents and \$61 for non residents. If absent for last class, report cards will be held at Comm. Ed. for two weeks.

**How to Register:** Fill in the registration blank on the reverse side of this sheet completely. Mail or bring the completed registration form and a check or cash to the Jenison Community Ed. Office, 2140 Bauer Road (located at Jenison H.S., in pool lobby behind ticket window). No phone registrations will be accepted, and class sizes are limited. Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis. You will not receive confirmation and will be notified only if a class is full or if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment. Make all checks payable to: Jenison Public Schools.

**Refund Policy:** A refund less \$10 will be granted up to 24 business hours prior to the start of class. Any refund requests made less than 24 hours prior to the start of the first class will not be granted due to minimum class requirements. No refunds will be given after the first class. No exceptions!
