

JENISON HIGH SCHOOL AQUATICS CENTER WINTER 2017 SWIM LESSONS

<u>Adult & Tot Classes (1:8 ratio)</u>: This class is designed for parent and baby (6-36+ mo.) to be in the water together. The instructor will guide the parents and work together to teach your child to enjoy the water at an early age with games, songs, and other fun activities. Age appropriate swimming skills and aquatic safety knowledge will be learned by the parent and child in this fun and interactive class.

<u>Preschool Aquatics Classes (1:4 ratio)</u>: Parents are invited to observe all classes from the pool deck bleachers. They must remain on the bleachers; and if the parent is a detriment to the child's ability to focus on the instructor, he or she may be asked to view from the balcony or not at all. This class is designed for three and four year olds, and five year olds who are not ready for Level 1, as their first class without a parent in the water with them. Children will work on basic swimming skills to help prepare them for our Level 1 class.

<u>Level Swim Lessons (Level 1, 1:5 ratio; Level 2+, 1:6 ratio)</u>: <u>Parents are invited to observe the first and last class (ONLY) to view their child's progress.</u> The fourth class is a mandatory Safety Day, and each child will receive a progress report. Children must be at least five years old with little or no swimming experience to register for Level 1 and must pass in order to proceed onto the next level.

Location: Swim lessons are held at the Jenison Aquatics Center, located at Jenison High School, 2140 Bauer Road. Enter the large, student parking lot on the west side of the high school building. Drive along the high school building toward the football stadium. When you see a large glass entryway, enter there and proceed into the pool lobby (you will see three trophy cases ahead and a stairwell to the pool balcony on your left). Follow the first hallway you come to on the right and enter the designated locker room (men's, women's, or family for those bringing children of the opposite gender).

<u>General Information</u>: Specific class requirements and descriptions can be found on our website at <u>www.jenisonaquatics.org</u>. Water temperature is approximately 81 degrees. For young children or children who need assistance in the bathroom, we ask that parents in our level classes stay in the family room during class to assist their child(ren) when necessary. The cost for Preschool Aquatics and Level Lessons is \$52/Jenison residents and \$62/non residents. The cost for Adult & Tot Power Lessons is \$39/residents and \$46/non residents. If absent for last class, report cards will be held at Comm. Ed. for two weeks. Private and semi-private lessons are available year round if these lessons do not fit your needs. Call Community Ed. for details.

How to Register: REGISTER ONLINE with a credit card at recpro.jpsonline.org, click Youth Programs, then Pool Programs; or fill in the registration blank on the reverse side of this sheet, and mail or bring the completed registration form to the Jenison Community Ed. Office, 8375 20th Ave. (located at JPS Center for the Arts). If not paying by credit card, please include a check or cash with your registration form. For your convenience after hours, a drop box is located outside the Black Box Entrance (right of main entrance). Class sizes are limited; and enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis. You will not receive confirmation and will be notified only if your first choice is full, cancelled due to low enrollment, or if your class needs to be altered in some way. Due to the nature of swim lessons, unfortunately, these calls are often made within 12-24 hours prior to the first class. Make all checks payable to: Jenison Public Schools.

<u>Refund Policy</u>: A refund less \$10 will be granted up to three business days prior to the start of class. Any refund requests made less than three business days prior to the start of the first class will not be granted due to minimum class requirements.
